

Hope Scarf pattern

Stats:

Yarn: 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ skeins of Lamb's Pride Bulky yarn (approx. 325 yds) or bulky yarn of choice (*use more yarn for longer scarf or super bulky yarn for a wider/longer scarf!*)

Needle: size 10.75 (7.0 mm) Addi Turbo knitting needles

Gauge: 3 sts = 1 inch in St. st., but gauge is not crucial

Size: 4.5 in. x 6 ft. (*depending on the yarn & your preference, you can widen the scarf during blocking process*)

Notions: cable needle, darning needle, st. markers

Pattern of Hope:

Row 1: p3, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p2, k12, p2, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p3

Row 2: k3, p3, k2, p12, k2, p3, k3

Row 3: p3, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p2, cb6, cf6, p2, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p3

Row 4: k3, p3, k2, p12, k2, p3, k3

Row 5: p3, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p2, k12, p2, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p3

Row 6: k3, p3, k2, p12, k2, p3, k3

Row 7: p3, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p2, k12, p2, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p3

Row 8: k3, p3, k2, p12, k2, p3, k3

Row 9: p3, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p2, cb6, cf6, p2, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p3

Row 10: k3, p3, k2, p12, k2, p3, k3

Row 11: p3, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p2, k12, p2, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p3

Row 12: k3, p3, k2, p12, k2, p3, k3

Row 13: p3, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p2, k12, p2, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p3

Row 14: k3, p3, k2, p12, k2, p3, k3

Row 15: p3, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p2, cf6, cb6, p2, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p3

Row 16: k3, p3, k2, p12, k2, p3, k3

Row 17: p3, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p2, k12, p2, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p3

Row 18: k3, p3, k2, p12, k2, p3, k3

Row 19: p3, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p2, k12, p2, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p3

Row 20: k3, p3, k2, p12, k2, p3, k3

Row 21: p3, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p2, cf6, cb6, p2, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p3

Row 22: k3, p3, k2, p12, k2, p3, k3

WHIMSICAL KNITTING DESIGNS



Cast on 28 sts. using long tail cast on.

Repeat the *Pattern of Hope* stitch pattern 16 times or until desired length is reached.

End with Rows 1 & 2.

Bind off in pattern.

Weave in ends.

****Design Note**** "*Pattern of Hope*" is customized from a stitch pattern in "A Treasury of Knitting Patterns" by Barbara Walker. Used by permission from Schoolhouse Press.

Stitch Key:

K: knit

P: purl

Sl 1 wyib: slip 1 stitch (purlwise) from left hand needle to right hand needle with yarn held in back.

Cb6-cable back 6: slip 3 sts onto a cable needle and hold the cable needle at the back of your work, knit the next 3 sts on the left needle; then knit the 3 sts from the cable needle.

Cf6-cable front 6: slip 3 sts onto a cable needle and hold the cable needle at the front of your work, knit the next 3 sts on the left needle; then knit the 3 sts from the cable needle.



****Addendum to Hope Scarf****

I have created an addendum to **Hope Scarf**, which will be **Hope Scarf II** for anyone who might want to knit a scarf that is a bit wider. I've not yet knit "*Hope Scarf II*" so there are no pictures, I'm sure the look will be very similar, just a bit wider. Please keep in mind that with the addition of these few extra stitches that the amount of yarn used will vary from that of **Hope Scarf**. Instructions are the same as those used with **Hope Scarf** except the addition of 8 stitches and you are to:

Cast on 34 stitches

Pattern of Hope II:

Row 1: p4, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p4, k12, p4, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p4
Row 2: k4, p3, k4, p12, k4, p3, k4
Row 3: p4, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p4, cb6, cf6, p4, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p4
Row 4: k4, p3, k4, p12, k4, p3, k4
Row 5: p4, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p4, k12, p4, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p4
Row 6: k4, p3, k4, p12, k4, p3, k4
Row 7: p4, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p4, k12, p4, k1, sl 1 wyib, k1, p4
Row 8: k4, p3, k4, p12, k4, p3, k4
